More about the mist.

Known as “nature’s germ killer,” hypochlorous disinfectant is what your own body uses to fight pathogens.

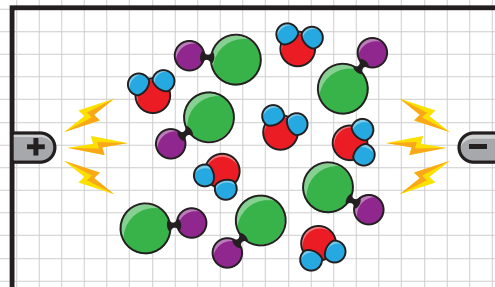
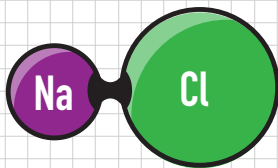
The mist is so safe, it is used to disinfect hospitals. It kills pathogens in seconds, but is utterly harmless to humans. The substance is what white blood cells use to fight off infections.

The disinfectant is FDA-approved to heal wounds, and for use in eye care products. It is USDA-approved to keep produce fresh, and for use in organic crop production.

It is 100x more efficient than bleach at killing microbial pathogens.

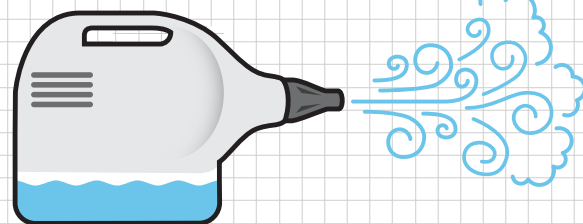
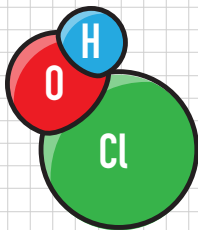
Hypochlorous disinfectant is 100% allergen-free, as certified by the Mayo Clinic SkinSafe product safety rating system.

THE MOLECULE THAT MAKES IT WORK



Our disinfectant mist begins with simple ingredients: a solution of salt and water.

Our misting machines pass an electric current through the solution.



This creates hypochlorous acid—HOCl—nature’s germ killer. (A byproduct, sodium hydroxide, is used in detergents.)

Vinegar brings down the pH level.

The mist is dispersed, killing pathogens and leaving no residue.
